Nick Klaus completes the swim portion of the Triathlon, running to get to his bike. . You made us Parrot Heads Proud Nick!!!!

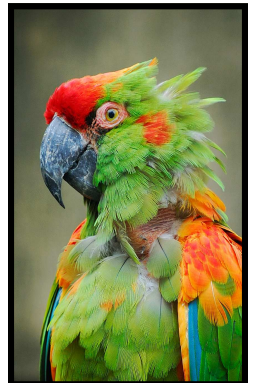
NOVEMBER BIRTHDAYS
